Introduction:

In 2018 we closed the annual report by stating that our main focus in 2019 would be raising funds to activate the Smart Breast Prosthesis Project, in addition to scaling-up board members and operational infra structure.

Milestones achieved in 2019:

1- We succeeded in getting the following sponsorships:

2- We started our collaboration for Breast Care Market Intelligence in the Netherlands, and Belgium with MVL Agency BV. MVL will play a key role in the recruitment of Mamma-Care Specialist, Retailers and Test Participants.
